<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 64557 consists of many white, angular clasts in a dark matrix that is probably an impact melt (Fig. 1). In some places the clasts and matrix have been swirled together in a marbled texture. It is a rake sample from the rim of a subdued doublet crater on Stone Mountain. Zap pits are rare or absent.
