


FIGURE 1. Aluminum cup bottom is 2 inches in diameter. S-72-42077.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 64828 is an extremely friable, light gray, clastic breccia with several white to dark gray clasts (Fig. 1). It is a rake sample from the rim of a small, subdued crater on Stone Mountain. Zap pits are absent.
