


FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 65329 is a white, friable anorthosite collected as a rake {ample (Fig. 1). It is subangular and has a granulated appearance. Plagioclase crystals up to 2 mm long are present. Tiny (<0.05 mm) dark flecks are scattered through the rock. Zap pits are rare.
