


FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 65346 is a light gray, friable breccia collected as a rake sample (Fig. 1). Clasts include white anorthositic material (~0.5 mm), gray aphanitic fragments (~0.7 mm), possibly some glass spherules and rare metal. It is subrounded with rare zap pits.

<u>PROCESSING AND SUBDIVISIONS</u>: During initial processing in 1972, 65346 broke into three subequal pieces (Fig. 1).
