




FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm. Photos are of two separate pieces.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 65735 is a light gray, friable breccia collected as a rake sample (Fig. 1). Clasts of gray, crystalline rock (~1 mm), white, anorthositic material (~1 mm) and rare fragments of a yellow mafic(?) silicate (up to 3 mm) are present. It is subangular with few zap pits.

<u>PROCESSING AND SUBDIVISIONS</u>: During initial processing and macroscopic examination in 1972, this rock fell into two subequal pieces (Fig. 1). Both are grouped as 65735,0.
