


FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 65747 is a pale brown, friable breccia collected as a rake sample (Fig. 1). Abundant clasts of white, anorthositic material (~0.8 mm) and gray, crystalline rock (~1 mm) and a few grains of a yellow mafic silicate rest in a very fine-grained matrix. It is rounded with few zap pits.
