<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 65765 is a coherent breccia apparently composed of only two lithologies: a white, brecciated anorthosite (~75% of the rock) and a dark gray, clast-laden breccia which is probably an impact melt. A thin layer of soil and glass coats one surface of the anorthosite. Zap pits are absent from this subangular rake sample.




FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm.
