


FIGURE 1. Smallest scale division in mm.

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 65769 is a light brownish gray, friable breccia partially coated by thin, vesicular glass (Fig. 1). The glass is gray green, contains a variety of clasts and many of its vesicles are filled with soil. The rock is subangular and devoid of zap pits. One face has a sheared appearance.
