LRV-5, 3.69 g**INTRODUCTION**

74117 is a rounded, very friable sample of regolith breccia, collected from the light mantle 700 m northwest of Station 3. It is a light gray polymict breccia. The sample is one of the smallest of 5 similar pieces picked from regolith sample 74110 that was collected as light mantle material. LRV-5 is on

the ejects blanket of a 15-m crater and 74117 probably represents ejects, possibly lithified by the impact. The fragments were observed during preliminary examination to contain about 10% white clasts and a trace of dark clasts in a light gray matrix. All the samples are rounded and shed fine-grained material. No subdivisions of 74117 have been made.
